



Step by Step Registering for Voyent Alert Phone Call Alerts

1. Go to <https://ca.voyent-alert.com/vras/client.html#!/registration> from any computer. You must be able to receive a confirmation phone call from the telephone number you enter to finish the registration. Enter an address or postal code for the location you'd like to receive alerts from.









4. Enter the phone number you'd like to receive alerts at. Click the boxes to show you accept the terms and conditions and provide consent to receive notifications.




